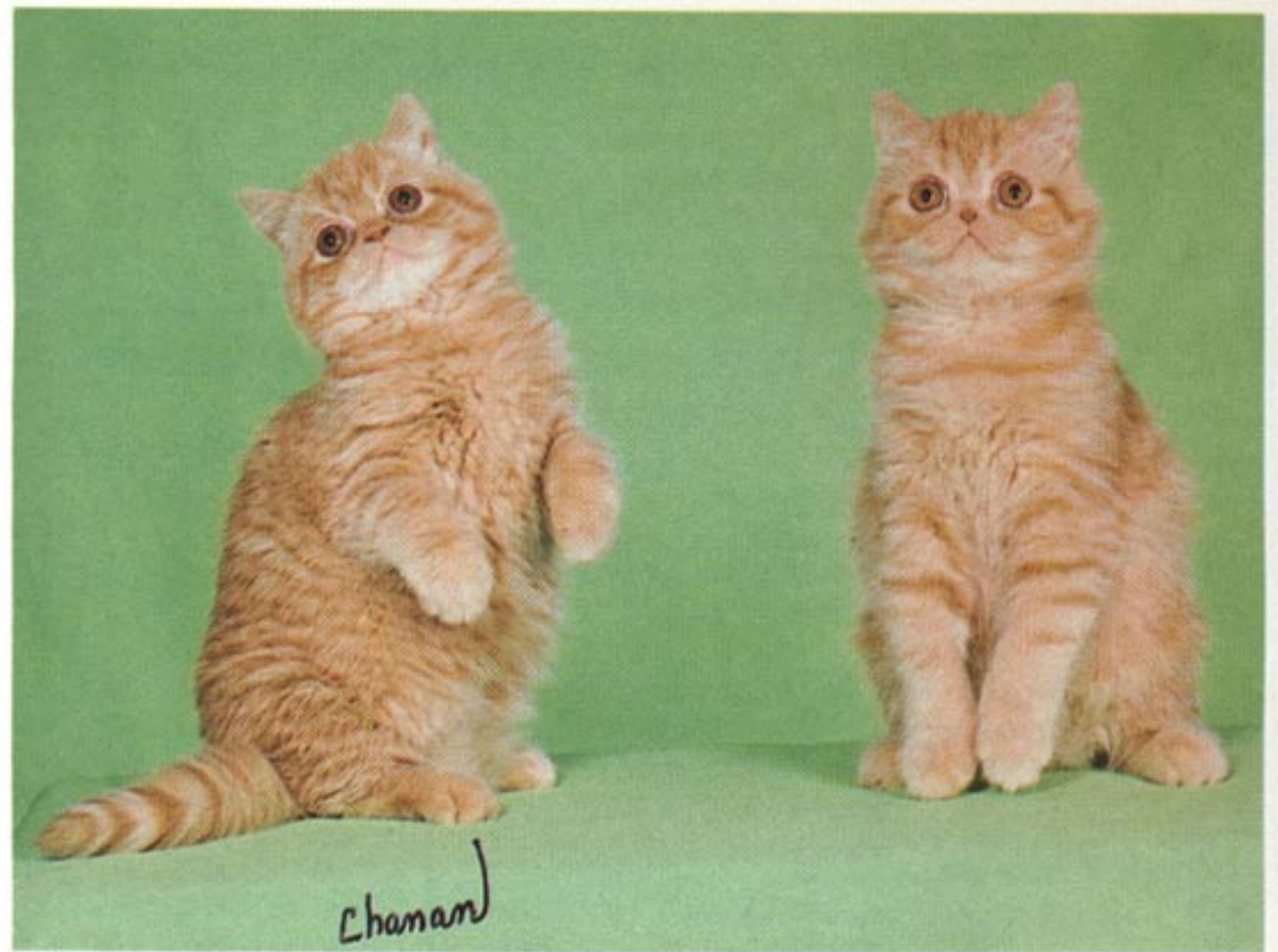
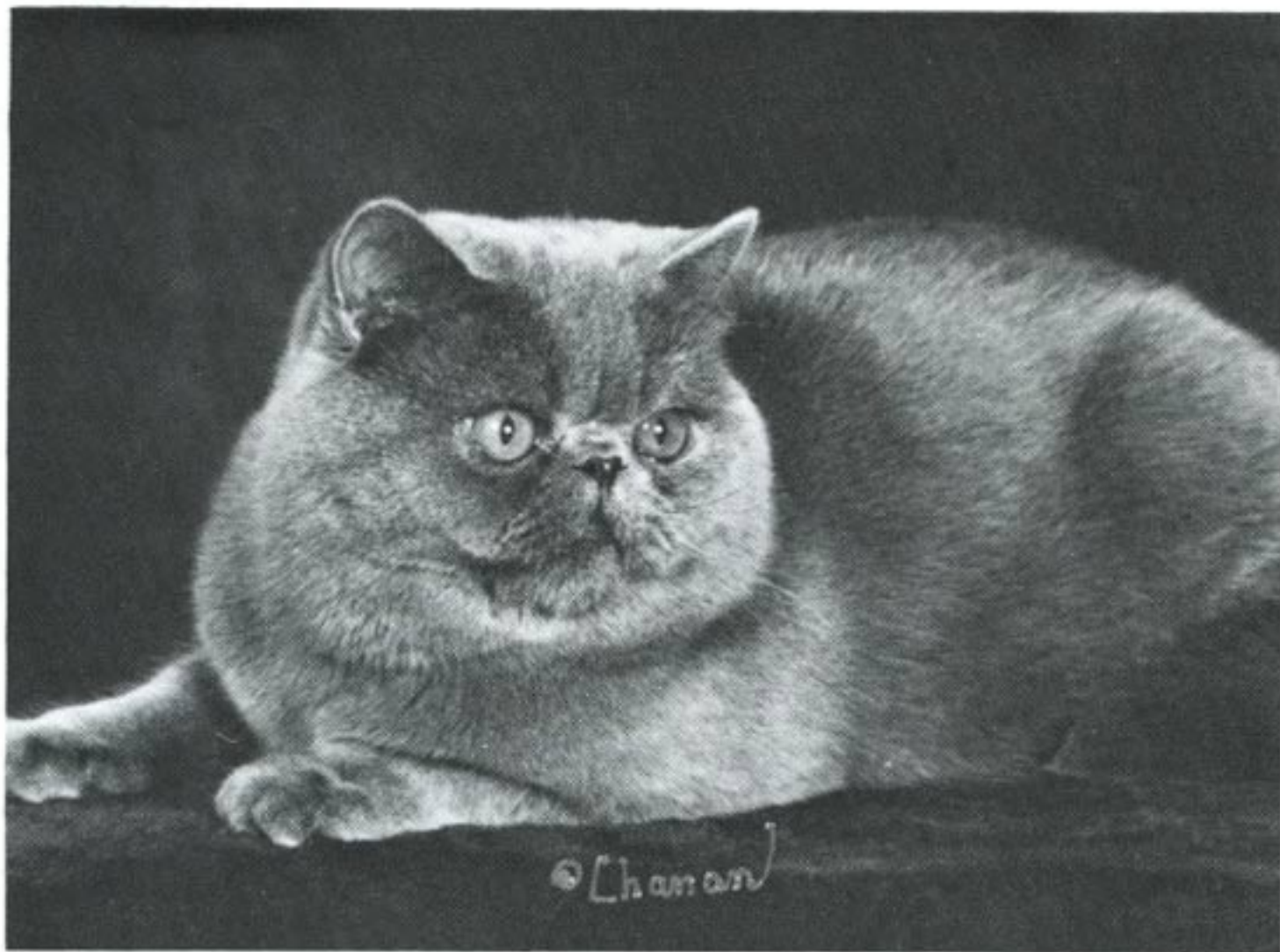




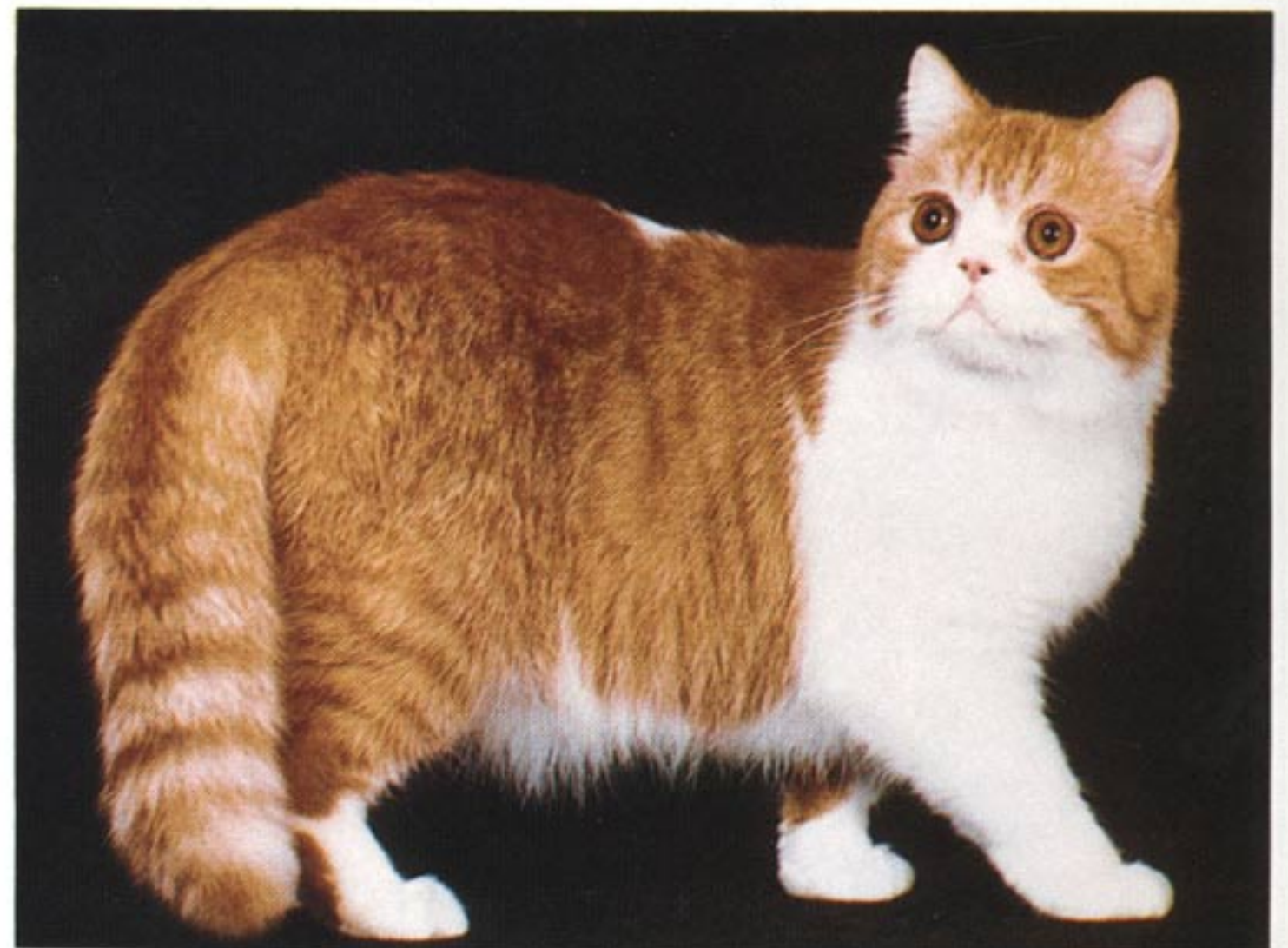

Even though I wholeheartedly approve of some of the new colors, I have reservations about others — both new and existing. Let's not forget that the beauty of an animal comes from a harmony of all parts. Unclear, indistinct patterns and muddled colors distract from an animal's overall beauty. Therefore, I believe that such cats (no matter how good their type) should be regarded strictly as breeders.

National Awards

Since their incredible breakthrough in 1973/74, Exotic Shorthairs were honored with national award wins almost every year. Only in 1982 and in 1985 did no Exotics make it to the top. In addition to **GRC Docia-Dao Trilby**, who was a three time national award winner, another cat received top honors as a kitten, and as an adult. **GRC Kalamar's Sweet Pea of Swany** was 2nd Best Kitten in 1974 and 3rd Best Cat in 1975.

Docia-Dao, Lowlands, New Dawn and Swany are the only catteries who have produced more than one national award winning cat. Trilby and Supercat have already been mentioned. **GRC Docia-Dao's Super Colossal** was awarded 3rd Best Kitten in 1975. **GRC Lowlands Maybelline** was 10th Best Cat in 1977 and **GRC & GRP Lowlands Christie of Docia-Dao** was 9th Best Cat in Premiership in 1980. Maybelline and Christie, by the way, are littermates. The New Dawn national award winners were: **GRC New Dawn Short Stop** - 15th Best Cat in 1979, **CH New Dawn Le'Lani of Colchester** (copper-eyed white female) - 6th Best Kitten in 1981 and **GRC New**

Dawn Son-Fire Salute of Gwenlar (copper-eyed white male) - 5th Best Kitten in 1983. **GRC Swany's That Other Woman** was Best Shorthair Kitten in 1976 and **GRC Swany's Jade of Chateau Blanc** was 17th Best Cat in 1978.

Between 1973 and 1984, Exotic Shorthairs have placed in the top 20/10/10 twenty-one (21) times. This number is surpassed only by the American Shorthair (25 times), Siamese (26 times), Burmese (30 times) and Persians (195 times). All of these are long established breeds. No other new breed has yet experienced such an enormous success as the Exotic Shorthair. Below is a complete list of National Award Winners and a list of the Best and 2nd Best of Breed recipients. (2nd Best of Breed wins were not given by CFA prior to 1980.)

The Grande Finale

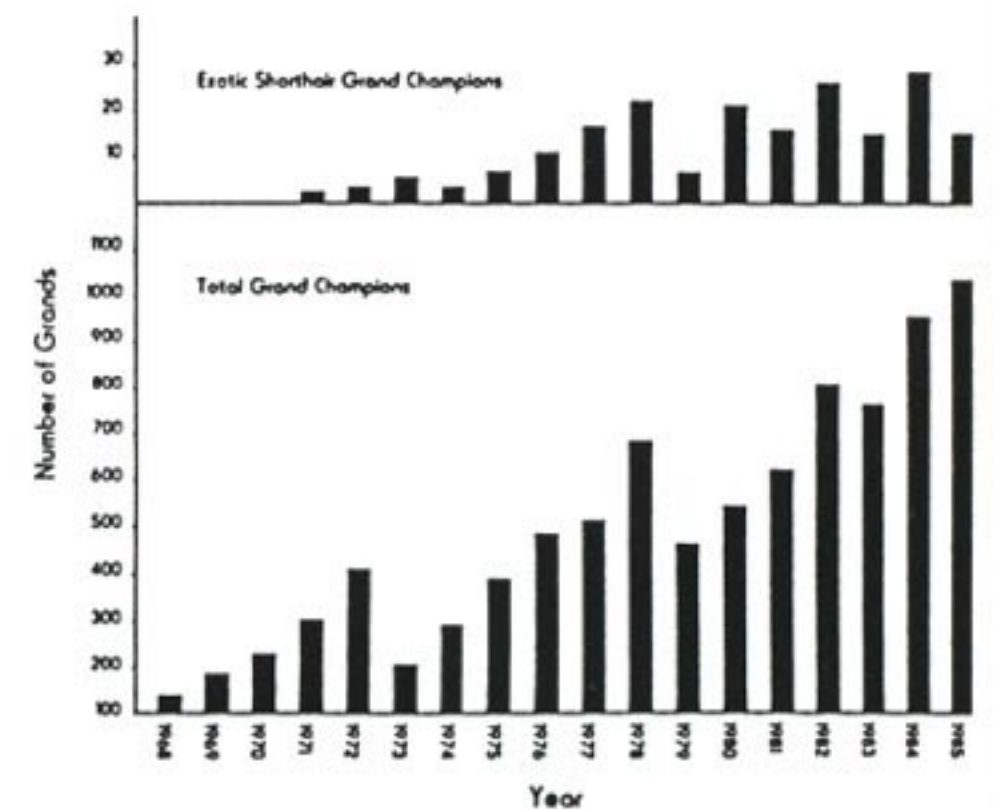


Fig. 4: Total CFA Grand Champions and Exotic Shorthair Grand Champions between 1968 and 1985

The first Exotic Shorthairs graded in 1971. Between then and now, the number of Exotic grands has increased steadily from three (3) in 1971 to twenty-seven (27) in 1982 and 1984. (Fig. 4, and Table 1) The annual percentage of CFA grands has increased only slightly over the years, with a small peak in 1980, when the number of Exotic grands reached 3.6% (Table 1). The dip in the total count of grands in 1973 and again in 1979 (Fig. 4) is due to the increase of grand points required: from 100 to 150 in 1973, and from 150 to 200 in 1979. Between these years, the total number of grands has risen steadily to a high of 1039 in 1985. Only fifteen Exotic Shorthairs graded during the 1984/85 season. This was the lowest percentage (1.4%) since 1971 and 1972. Between 1974 and 1984, 3048 Exotic Shorthairs have been registered with CFA. This is an average of 305 cats per year (110 males and 195 females). [Earlier counts were partly unobtainable, and partly incorrect.] During the same period of time, 176 (or 6%) of all registered Exotic Shorthairs graded. It is impossible for me to compare these figures with other breeds. But, I think six out of one hundred is a very good average!

The color distribution among the Grand Champions is interesting. There are five major groups:

1. 78 Dilutes 39.8% (34 Bl; 24 Bl-Cr; 10 Cr; 6 CrT; 4 Bl(P)T)
2. 66 Dense 33.7% (25 Blk; 15 Tort; 17 Rd(Mc)T; 6 Br(Mc)T; 3 Rd)
3. 30 Shaded /Smokes 15.3% (11 Blk Sm; 9 Sh Si; 3 Ca(Mc)T; 2 Chin; 4 Si(P)T; 1 Sm T)
4. 13 Piebald 6.6% (5 Bi; 4 T&W; 2 Bl-Cr&W; 2 Cal)
5. 9 Whites 4.6% (7 CEW; 1 BEW; 1 OEW)

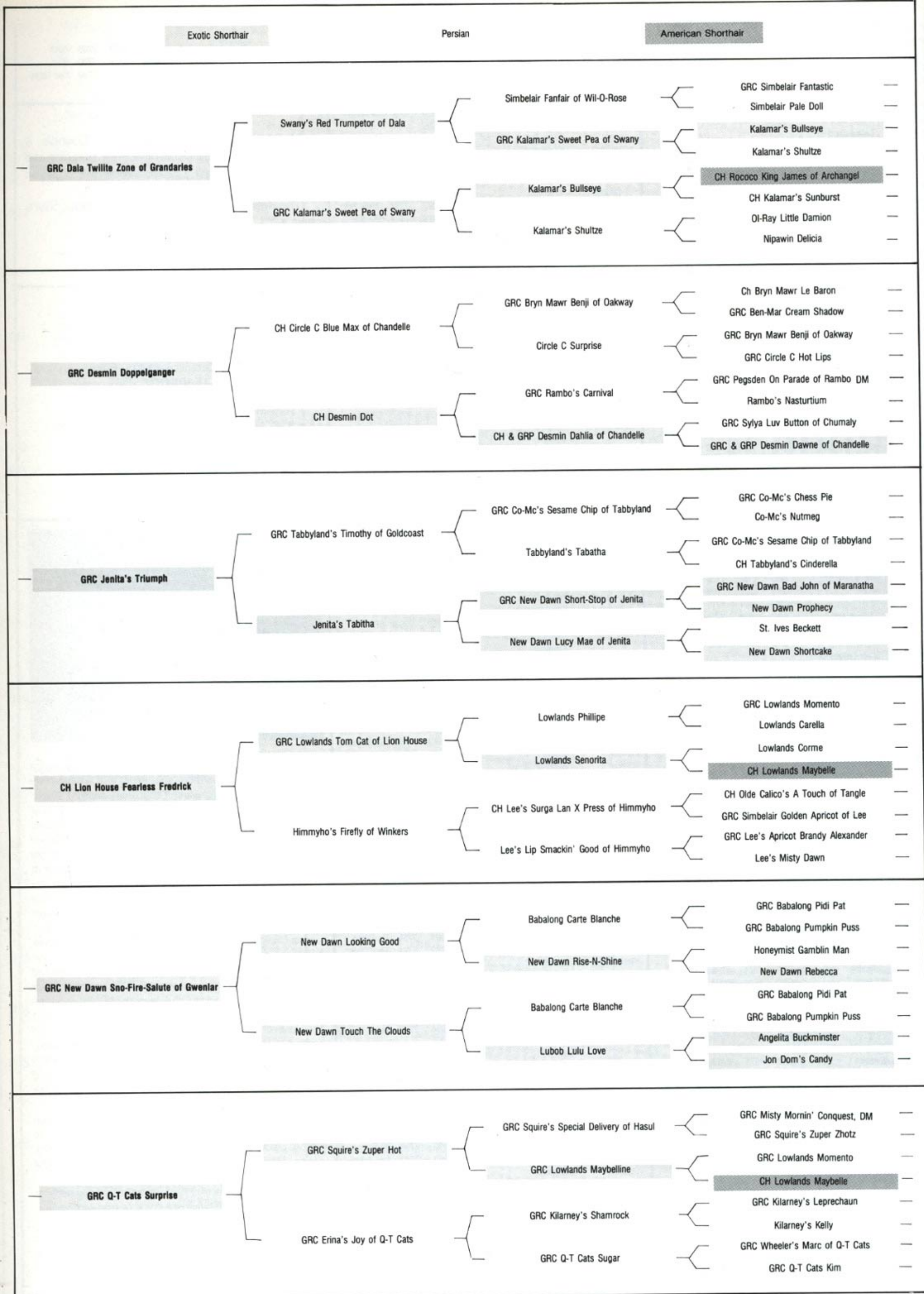

Johanna Döbler Leibfarth was born in Thuringia, which became part of East Germany after World War II. It was there that she began her professional education, studying animal husbandry and agriculture. In 1957 she escaped from East Germany for political reasons and went to live in Hannover, West Germany. There she continued her studies and received the equivalent of a Bachelor's degree in horticulture from the University of Münster. Following this, she obtained a post at the Veterinary Medical College in Hannover and began her training as an electronmicroscopist. She emigrated to the United States in 1965 and the following year joined a research team at St. Luke's Hospital Center, a teaching hospital of Columbia University, which was working on genetic, biophysical, biochemical, medical and ultrastructural aspects of human hemoglobin. She is co-author of nine scientific papers published on this subject. She went to France in 1979 spending a year at the Institut de Pathologie Cellulaire at the Hôpital de Bicêtre and, following this, was appointed to a faculty position at the University of Florida in Gainesville, where she taught and trained students in electronmicroscopy. After sixteen years, she decided to give up her work in ultrastructural research and she moved to Augusta. Here, at the Medical College of Georgia, she joined my husband as an assistant in his genetic research on human hemoglobin.

In 1982, she married Ed Leibfarth, and has since given up her work in the medical field to devote herself full-time to her two childhood dreams - working with animals and graphic design. Many people by now are familiar with her delightful and beautifully executed logos.

Johanna has told me that her interest in breeding pedigree cats was first triggered when she came to stay with my husband and me in Jamaica. We had come out to the West Indies from a village in Buckinghamshire and we told her about our two friends there, Laura Lushington and Sonia Halliday, who were the first to introduce the Turkish Van cats to England. Then she learned about the Cat Fancy, and her spontaneous fascination with this new-found hobby, especially the genetic aspects of it, grew over the years more than, at the outset, she ever anticipated. She has been Show Manager several times, she is a CFA Master Clerk.
